

### **Behavior Analyst Internship at Pediatric Partners**

We offer individuals working toward becoming a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA), or Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA), the opportunity to gain experience hours through supervised independent fieldwork. Interns should expect to be immersed in the field of applied behavior analysis by our team of BCBAs. Daily immersive activities include weekly individual supervision with our Pediatric Partner BCBAs, group supervision led by Dr. Jordan Lill, PhD, LBA, BCBA-D, direct patient care, direct assessment, parent training, and learning supervision skills. Behavior Analysis Interns also may lead student projects, participate in skill assessments, functional behavior assessments, and parent training.

Behavior Analysis internships are supervised by Dr. Jordan Lill, PhD, LBA, BCBA-D. Interns will also receive direct supervision by the BCBAs of Pediatric Partners. All supervisors have completed the Supervisor Training series required by the Behavior Analysis Certification Board (BACB). Pediatric Partners utilizes a two-tier approach to providing supervision for Behavior Analysis Interns. First, Interns will receive routine in-session, direct supervision. The goal of in-session supervision is to increase fluency and mastery of the implementation of ABA treatment techniques. Interns will receive weekly one-hour independent supervision provided by Dr. Lill. The goal of independent supervision is to provide Interns with the conceptual knowledge of strategies utilized within the session, as well as discuss current research and relevant items on the <u>BACB Task List 5</u>.

Following an immersive internship with Pediatric Partners, Interns would have the fieldwork experience hours to apply and sit for the Board exam. Upon completion and a passing score on the exam, Interns would be eligible for licensure in the State of North Dakota as well as Board Certification by the BACB. Licensure, Board Certification, and successfully completing the internship could lead to employment as a BCBA with Pediatric Partners.

### Experience opportunities:

- Weekly supervision opportunities, with at least six direct contacts
  - Possible to provide Concentrated Supervision Hours required by BACB
- Both restricted and unrestricted fieldwork experience available
- Monthly journal club
- Conducting skill-based assessments
- Designing and conducting functional behavior assessments
- Designing, applying, and teaching behavior intervention plans
- Implementing skill Acquisition, behavior-reduction programs, and generalization

- Parent Training
- Using and Applying Single-Subject Designs
